

○ **Personal Issues of Learners:-**

**Issues:-** Few learners during the semester came with the request of certain relaxation for attending the regular lectures in the name of practice and group work for the college fest and cultural events usually planned during 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of the year. Such learners were ready to come to college on daily basis and spend more than the usual working hours in the college premises but unable to attend the lectures due to extra-curricular event group.

**Resolved:-** In consultation with the principal of the institution, it was hereby allowed partially depending upon the interest and ability of the learners that few learners will be allowed relaxation for certain lectures after the recess time for putting their contribution in the group workings for the college fest-sports and cultural events provided they will be fulfilling the minimum attendance norms set by the institutions in such cases.

○ **Given instructions on internal test, attendance and defaulter**

During the semester, on frequent intervals the learners were being given instructions for conduction of college internal test, syllabus, time-table and examination rules. Also the instructions with relate to attendance report and defaulter meetings were being discussed. 

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


